CBSE EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

The various competitions have been conducted by CBSE during the session 2025-26 as per the given below details:

- **CBSE Reading Challenge** has been conducted successfully in two rounds where our students showed their talents by their active participations. Students from classes VI to X participated in reading challenge organized by CBSE. Two students from each class were selected as per their good score and participated enthusiastically in the competition.
- **An Anti-Doping Awareness Webinar** was organized for Physical Education (PE) teachers to enhance their understanding of fair play, athlete welfare and anti-doping regulations in sports. The session was conducted under the guidelines of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) and CBSE's Fit India initiative. The session proved highly informative and beneficial, equipping PE teachers with the right knowledge to educate students, promote drug-free sports culture and ensure the well-being of upcoming athletes.
- **National Reading Day** Our School enthusiastically celebrated **National Reading Day** to promote the joy of reading and develop strong literacy habits among students. The day commemorated the contributions of P.N. Panicker, the father of the Library Movement in India. Students from various classes participated in a range of engaging reading activities such as silent reading sessions, story sharing, book reviews and library visits. Teachers encouraged students to explore different genres, inspiring them to read beyond their textbooks.
- **First CBSE Expression Series:** Our school enthusiastically participated in the First CBSE Expression Series, providing students with a platform to express their ideas creatively through essays, poems, and artwork. significance of Diwali but also fostered a sense of unity and camaraderie within our school community, illuminating hearts with the spirit of togetherness and celebration.



Intra-school Activities/Competitions




